For those who have attended School Board meetings in the past, you may be familiar with the rules below, as set by the Board President and policy.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

During Public Comments, Board members will not answer questions or engage in discussion with members of the public. This is the public's time to speak and the Board's time to listen.

: If you are here to participate during public comment, you will have three minutes to speak, time permitting. Each person is allowed one opportunity to testify on a non-agenda/non-action item. When 30 seconds remain, a bell will ring to inform you so that you can finish your sentence. When 20 seconds remain, a bell will ring to inform you so that you can finish your sentence.

The School Board welcomes the public to observe and contribute to our meetings through comments, but to be productive, our meetings must be structured and civil.
